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## NOTES

1. **ATTENDANCE** – Attendance will be reviewed quarterly instead of annually. NSCC Regulations state that you must attend **75%** of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC/NLCC.

2. **UNIFORMS / INSPECTION** - All cadets need to ensure that they are inspection ready, males haircuts, uniforms are worn correctly and that all articles of the uniform are worn (Belts, T-Shirts, socks and covers) and are cleaned and pressed all required insignias, and flashings are correctly affixed to the uniforms and boots and or shoes must be polished.

- **PT uniform includes:** Yellow issued t-shirt, blue issued shorts, white socks (socks must come up the calf no ankle socks permitted), tennis shoes and a form of hydration.
- **NWU Type I:** Blue t-shirt, Black boot socks, NWU top and bottom, belt with buckle, black boots, boot blousers, 8-point cover, pistol belt, canteen complete with canteen cup and cover.
- **NWU Type III:** Brown t-shirt, Black boot socks, Type III top and bottom, belt with buckle, black boots, boot blousers, 8-point cover, pistol belt, canteen complete with canteen cup and cover

**\*\*The ID Card is a MANDATORY part of every uniform. Each cadet should always be able to present their ID Card!\*\***

3. **COURSEWORK** - All Cadets are responsible for their progress in Polaris. This is the best way to ensure they know the coursework, knowledge and are prepared for the next rank/rate which will keep them prepared and moving forward. Each rank/rate has required coursework and/or training before the cadet can progress. Monitoring Polaris is a good way to ensure that you are not missing any required coursework. Please call or text the Training Officer if you have any questions.

5. **CHOW**- Cadets inform your parents that chow will be provided at the POST for \$3.00 or have the option to bring their meal for chow. We will need to know in advance how many cadets will be bring a meal for chow on the Thursday of each meal, so that we can plan accordingly without over preparing or under prepare meals provided at the POST.

6. **PT/PRT** - is now authorized to continue with stringent COVID-19 safety guidelines. We will begin having cadet led PT at each drill strictly adhering to the new guidelines in place. It is important that cadets arrive in PT gear and have water as hydration is incredibly important especially since the weather will quickly begin warming up. If you have any questions regarding the PT guidelines, we will be happy to provide it to you. Cadets will change into NWU's after PT.

- **PRT is not authorized to be administered at the unit level.** This does not prevent the cadet from completing PRT. Parents are authorized to administer the PRT to their cadets (1-mile run, push-ups and curls ups [modified sit ups]) and then report the results to the Training officer to input for the cadet's records. Be advised that PRT will be required for trainings which are often physically demanding so ensuring your cadet is doing PT on their own to prepare for their PRT will help them succeed and excel.

7. **Remind** your parents that drills start at **0800 hrs.** and you are required to remain in the vehicles until a staff member checks your temperature. Drill secures at 1600 hrs., parents must be on time, to ensure that all cadets are picked up promptly. All parents or guardians must come into the hall to be identified as the cadets authorized person to pick up cadets or the cadet will not be released. Also inform your parents and or guardian's that if they are permitting anyone other than the parents or guardians listed to pick up a cadet they have to be 18 years of age, your parents or guardians must provide us with a written authorization and information of who will be permitted to pick up the cadet and they must have a valid ID and must be an adult.

- ❖ **27 March – Central Florida Ride for Our Troops** (This is a volunteer opportunity. This is **NOT** mandatory. Parents please be advised that while all instructors and officers maintain the NSCC standards around cadets this event will have outside patrons attending that we will have no control over.
