06 FEB 21 AT 1900HRS. WILL BE A MANDATORY ZOOM MEETING BOTH PARENT AND CADETS MUST ATTEND TO UNDERSTAND THE CHECK IN PROCESS, REQUIRED DOCUMENTS, UNIFORMS AND GEAR REQUIRED FOR THE TRAININGS.

2. **RECRUITING EVENT DRILL-** All cadets, officers and staff are to report to Osceola Heritage Park for Drill on 20 FEB 21.

Uniform will be NWU's for Cadets and Officers, we will have a table set up for information and Recruiting. Cadets and Staff will rotate in shifts to man the table. Please contact Ens. Benitez to provide you availability to work at the Recruiting Table.

EVENT DATES ARE AS FOLLOWS: 12 FEB 2021 thru 21 FEB 2021

The shifts during the week will be:

Monday-Thursday: 1600hrs-2100hrs need 2 Adults and if possible 2 Cadets each day!

Friday- Sunday: 1100hrs-1630hrs need 2 adults and 2 cadets and 1630hrs-2200hrs need 2 adults and 2 cadets each day!

3. **CHOW-** Cadets inform your parents you need to bring \$3.00 or have the option to bring their meal for chow. We will need to know in advance how many cadets will be bring a meal for chow on the Thursday of before each drill, so that we can plan accordingly without over preparing or under prepare meals provided.

4. **Remind** your parents that drills start at **0800 hrs.** and you are required to remain in the vehicles until a staff member checks your temperature. Drill secures at 1600 hrs., parents must be on time, to ensure that all cadets are picked up promptly. All parents or guardians must always come into the hall to be identified as the cadets authorized person to pick up cadets. Also inform your parents and or guardian's that if they are permitting anyone other than the parents or guardians listed to pick up a cadet, they must be 18 years of age, your parents or guardians must provide us with a written authorization and information of who will be permitted to pick up the cadet and they must have a valid ID and must be an adult.

5. Please ensure all cadets have their **Cadet ID's** and ensure they bring duty belt and canteen filled with water to hydrate.

6. **ATTENDANCE** – Attendance will be reviewed quarterly instead of annually. NSCC Regulations state that you must attend **75%** of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC/NLCC.
